




Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




Count of 2. How well did the teacher prepare for the classes?



Count of 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




### Count of 4. The Teachers approach to teaching can be best described as





### Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by all the teachers








Count of 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional





Count of 9. The institution provides multiple oppourtunities to learn and grow.





Count of 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow up with an assigned task to you.







# Count of 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications





Count of 13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges-



Count of 14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them




Count of 15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of





Count of 16. The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning





## Count of 17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.






Count of 19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching.
