Institutional Best Practices 2017-18

Newly added Practice (2017-18)

"Prevention of cruelty against straying animals"

N.S.S. unit of the college has set a motto in this session to spread a message among students regarding humanity towards strayed animals in the town. IQAC of the college has already an MOU with "Prayas Gau Seva Sansthan, Champa", an association to serve Cows. Under this practice, students of the college, along with member of this association reach to the ailing or injured cattle to provide them necessary medical and other helps. The aim of this practice is to help these animals to recover from their pathetic condition. NAAC/IQAC Coordinator and N.S.S. Coordinator personally monitor these activities.

Existing Best Practices

"Contribution for National Foundation for Communal Harmany"

National foundation for Communal Harmany (NFCH) was setup as an autonomous organization under the society's registration Act 1860 and registered on 19 February 1992 with the main objective of providing assistance to the physical and psychological rehabilitation of the child victims of communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence with special reference to their health care and education.

College receives a circular from NFCH every year. As soon as this circular is received college issue/notifies this for the students and staff. In this way every year a good amount is sent to NFCH as a bit of contribution from our side. In the year 2017-18 Rs. 2080.00 rupees is contributed by the students and staff of the college.

"Self generated scholarship for the students"

A fixed deposit was made by Shri Akhilesh Pandey an ex-student of the college for Annual Scholarship to M.S.W./M.A. (Sociology) topper. Shri Pandey is one of the pass out students of this college. He has deposited Rs. 10000.00 for this cause. A scholarship of Rs. 1000.00 is given from the interest incurred out of this deposit every year. This year two more such scholarships were extended by Dr. B.D. Diwan for M.Sc. topper and by Dr. Bharti Sharma for College topper.
